## Northern Athletics Conference women's volleyball awards announced

WAUKESHA, Wis. -- The Northern Athletics Conference has just released the All-Northern Athletics Conference awards for the 2008 women's volleyball season. The awards are voted on by the head women's volleyball coaches in the conference.

Concordia University Wisconsin's Katie Roessler (Wauwatosa, Wis.) was named the 2008 NAC Player of the Year. The junior middle hitter, also a First Team All-NAC selection, led the conference in hitting percentage (.320) and blocks (1.19 bpg), was third in kills (3.55 kpg), and tallied over 39 service aces (10th) for the Falcons (15-14, 8-4 NAC).

Maranatha Baptist Bible College's Kedra DeLozier (Watertown, Wis.) was chosen as NAC Defensive Player of the Year for 2008. The senior libero averaged 3.75 digs per game and had only 53 reception errors in 553 attempts. DeLozier was also a Second Team All-NAC selection.

Dominican University's Kimberly Wakeman (Indianapolis, Ind.) was selected at the top freshman player and named NAC Rookie of the Year. The freshman setter led the NAC in assists with a 8.49 per game average. Wakeman was also selected to the All-Rookie Team and was an Honorable Mention All-NAC selection.

Lakeland's Chad Schreiber was named NAC Coach of the Year, as selected by his peers. Schreiber's Muskies went a perfect 12-0 in conference play for the second consecutive season, and 25-10 overall. Lakeland also won the 2008 NAC Women's Volleyball Tournament for the second straight season, and earned the conference's automatic bid to the 2008 NCAA Division III Championship Tournament where they will face host UW-Oshkosh in the first round.
