CACC Notes

Caldwell - The Cougars won a pair of CACC matches last week after starting the week with an exciting, five-set loss to Southern Connecticut State on Monday. The team bounced back the next day with a 3-1 win at Post. Freshman right side **Amber Mosher**, who had 16 kills against SCSU, recorded 15 kills and a .500 hitting percentage to lead the Cougars over Post. On Saturday, sophomore outside hitter **Justine Pecora** tallied 11 kills as Caldwell cruised past Goldey-Beacom in three sets.

Felician - Felician overcame a 24-17 deficit to win Set 1 in an eventual 3-0 (28-26 26-24 25-22) victory at Dominican last Tuesday. Saturday's loss to Wilmington snapped a four-match regular-season conference winning streak dating back to last season.

Georgian Court - The Lions have won eight of their last nine matches.

Holy Family - Holy Family swept its week of play and dropped only one set in a 4-0 week to improve its record to 9-9 and 3-0 in the CACC. The Tigers opened the week with a 3-1 home win over Wilmington (Del.) on Tuesday. **Jen O'Connor**, in her first match as a setter since her freshman year, recorded a double-double with 35 assists and 10 digs. Outside hitter **Aly Keihl** added 12 digs and 10 kills. Outside hitter **Katie Hornback** had 13 kills and nine digs. On Thursday, the Tigers downed Goldey-Beacom 3-0. O'Connor recorded another double-double with 28 assists and 10 digs. Outside hitter **Kelsey Ross** led the offense with eight kills. Holy Family ended the week by sweeping a tri-match with St. Anselm (3-0) and NYIT (3-0). Hornback had 11 kills and a hitting percentage of .500 against St. Anselm. Middle hitter **Mallory Lennon** added 10 kills against the Hawks. Against NYIT, Hornback had 10 kills and nine digs and O'Connor had 35 assists. The Tigers have four matches again this week, as they welcome Chestnut Hill on Tuesday, travel to Georgian Court on Thursday and host a tri-match with Felician and Mercy.

Philadelphia - The Lady Rams picked up three wins last week, including a 3-0 shutout of Chestnut Hill. Junior **Nicole Berkstresser** and **Celena Rendon** both had a team-leading 27 kills for the week, and freshmen **Emma Claffy** (1.6kpg) and **Julie Niblock** (1.44kpg) both had breakout performances. Phila U. hosts Goldey-Beacom (9/30) and Post (10/4) in its only matches of the week.

USP - Senior **Claire Tauschek** (Verona, Wis.) became USP's all-time leader in digs recording her 1,881st dig in the second set of USP's 3-2 win over Southern New Hampshire. Tauschek finished the match with 21 digs to give her 1,896 for her career. USP rallied from an 0-2 deficit to defeat Southern New Hampshire 3-2 on Saturday, marking the first time USP has recovered from an 0-2 deficit since the 2004 season when they overcame an 0-2 deficit to beat Holy Family 3-2. USP also rallied from a 2-1 deficit to defeat Post University 3-2 on Saturday. Post led 6-1 in the final set before the Devils outscored them 14-1 to win the set 15-7 and take the match. With 48 kills during the week sophomore **Christine Puschak** (Leola, Pa.) moved into seventh place on the Devils' all-time list with 478. Junior **Andrea Cardine** (Temple, Pa.) also moved up on USP's all-time kill list, sliding into eighth place behind Puschak with 426 career kills. Puschak and Cardine also moved up to eighth and ninth place respectively on USP's all-time service ace list – Puschak's nine aces this week gives her 85 for her career while Cardine had six aces on the week to give her 84 for her career.
