Celena Rendon, Philadelphia (Jr., OH, San Antonio, TX) - Averaged 4.17 kills, 3.0 digs, 0.50 blocks and 0.83 service aces per-set while posting a .360 hitting percentage in a 2-0 week. Recorded 18 kills, 13 digs, three aces and three blocks in a 3-1 triumph over Post.



CACC Co-Rookies of the Week

Katie Hornback, Holy Family (Fr., OH, 5-11, Indianapolis, IN) and Titilola Alao, Caldwell (Fr., MB, 5-10, Ossining, NY) - Hornback averaged 2.67 kills and 1.75 digs per-set at a .307 attack percentage in a 3-1 week. CACC Notes

Caldwell - The Cougars maintained a .500 record after going 2-2 last week. Caldwell lost to the two CACC divisional leaders in Bloomfield and Georgian Court, and also defeated Molloy and Chestnut Hill. Freshman middle blocker **Titilola Alao** had 17 kills and five total blocks to help lead the Cougars past Molloy in a five-set non-conference match on Thursday.

Georgian Court - The Lions have won seven straight and 13 of their last 14 matches. GCU has shutout its opponent in five straight matches. Eight of their last nine victories have been in straight sets. The Lions remain unbeaten (8-0) in their new home, the GCU Wellness Center.

Holy Family - Holy Family went 3-1 in its four matches last week to improve to 12-10 overall and 5-1 in the CACC South. The Tigers defeated Chestnut Hill on Tuesday, 3-0. Defensive specialist **Kelly Cummins** set the NCAA Division II record for most consecutive points served by serving 20 straight times in the second set. On Thursday, Holy Family fell to Georgian Court, 3-0, snapping the Tigers five-match winning streak. Outside hitter **Jill Keeve** led the offense with nine kills. Holy Family ended the week by knocking off Felician and Mercy by 3-0 scores. Outside hitter **Katie Hornback** led the attack against Felician with nine kills and seven service aces. Middle hitter **Mallory Lennon** added eight kills. Hornback and middle hitter **Rebecca Tett** led the way against Mercy with 10 and seven kills, respectively. This week, Holy Family travels to Kutztown on Wednesday. The Golden Bears defeated the Tigers 3-2 last month. On Saturday, Holy Family hosts Dominican.

Philadelphia - The Lady Rams were undefeated this week with wins over Goldey-Beacom and Post. They will now hit the road for three straight CACC matches.

USP - USP has now won four straight matches and five of its last six. **Going the Distance:** With their 3-2 win over Wilmington, the Devils are now 3-1 in five-set matches at the Bobby Morgan Arena this season and 6-2 lifetime since the building opened in 2003. **In Attack Mode:** Sophomore **Christine Puschak** (Leola, Pa.) recorded 27 kills this week to move into seventh place on the Devils all-time list with 452 for her career. **Ace High:** Junior **Andrea Cardine** (Temple, Pa.) moved into eighth place on the Devils all-time service ace list with three this week to bring her career total to 87. Speaking of aces, senior **Claire Tauschek** (Verona, Wis.) is just five aces away from becoming the Devils all-time leader with 197. **Dig this:** Junior **Kirsten Lechner** (Wayne, N.J.) became just the 11th player in school history to record 500 career digs, reaching the mark against Dominican. Tauschek needs just 51 digs to reach 2,000 for her career.
