CACC Player of the Week

Claire Tauschek, USP (Sr., L, 5-8, Verona, WI) - Led USP to a 3-0 week by averaging 6.0 digs and 0.55 service aces per-set. Against Chestnut Hill, became the first USP and CACC player to record 2,000 career digs. She becomes the 37th player in NCAA Division II history to do so. Racked up 32 digs in a 5-set win over Goldey-Beacom.

CACC Co-Rookies of the Week

Katie Hornback, Holy Family (Fr., OH, 5-11, Indianapolis, IN) and **Rebekah Waybrant, Philadelphia (Fr., OH, 5-10, Gettysburg, PA)** - Hornback averaged 4.17 kills, 1.0 digs and 0.83 blocks per-set in a 2-0 week. Recorded 14 kills against Kutztown and 11 vs. Dominican. Waybrant averaged 1.33 kills at a .243 hitting percentage along with 0.33 blocks per-set in a 3-1 week for the Lady Rams.

Honorable Mention

Aimee Drabyn, Holy Family (So., S, Avon, IN) - Averaged 10.17 assists and 2.0 digs per-set in two wins last week.

Ann Casado, Georgian Court (Sr., OH/S, 5-6, Brick, NJ) - Averaged 3.55 kills at a .360 hitting percentage, along with 2.27 digs per-set.

Ashley Carberry, Wilmington (Sr., MH, 5-10, Newark, DE) - Averaged 3.71 kills and 1.0 blocks per-set along with a .429 hitting percentage in three matches.

Jussara Oliveira, Bloomfield (Fr., OH, 5-10, Belo Horizonte, Brazil) - Registered 3.67 kills at a .358 attack percentage and 2.5 digs per-set in a 2-0 week.

CACC Notes

Caldwell - The Cougars improved to 5-2 in the CACC with a 3-0 triumph over Felician on Thursday in their only match of the week. The victory gave Caldwell an overall record of 8-7 and matched the school record for wins in a season. Freshman right side **Amber Mosher** had a team-high 12 kills and a .207 hitting percentage.

Felician - Sophomore **Erica Moore** averaged 5.40 digs per-set in her second week since moving back to her freshman position of libero, taking over the team lead with a 2.89 average for the season.

Georgian Court - The Lions have won 10 straight and 16 of their last 17 matches. Georgian Court remains unbeaten (9-0) in their new home, the GCU Wellness Center, and is 9-0 versus the CACC.

Holy Family - Holy Family picked up another two wins to move its overall record to 14-10. The Tigers defeated Kutztown and Dominican (N.Y.) by 3-0 scores. Holy Family is now 6-1 in CACC play after its win on Saturday over the Chargers. Against Kutztown, outside hitter **Katie Hornback** led the charge with 14 kills. Setter **Aimee Drabyn** added 31 assists. In the win over Dominican, Hornback and Drabyn both paced the offense again. Hornback had 11 kills and Drabyn recorded 30 assists. This week, Holy Family has a pair of CACC matches against Philadelphia (Tuesday at home) and at Post (Saturday).

Philadelphia - The Lady Rams were 3-1 on the road this week, taking three straight 3-0 wins to end the week. Their only two losses in nearly a month both came to Georgian Court.

USP - And the Streak goes on: The Devils extended their winning streak to a school record seven matches this week, defeating Goldey Beacom, Chestnut Hill and Nyack to improve to 8-9 on the year. USP is 8-1 in its last nine matches after starting the season 0-8. **Let's Play Five:** For the sixth time this season, the Devils have been extended to five sets in a match, when they defeated Goldey-Beacom 3-2 on Tuesday. USP is 4-1 at the Bobby Morgan Arena in these matches and 4-2 this season in five-set contests. **2000+ Club: Claire Tauschek** (Verona, Wis.) became the first USP player to record 2,000 career digs getting 19 against Chestnut Hill to give her exactly 2,000. Now with 2,015, Tauschek ranks 36th on the NCAA Division II all-time list. **Holding All Aces:** Tauschek also became USP's all-time service ace leader with two aces against Nyack, giving her 198 for her career. Claire is one of just 10 volleyball players in NCAA Division II history to have both 2,000+ digs and 185+ aces in their career.
